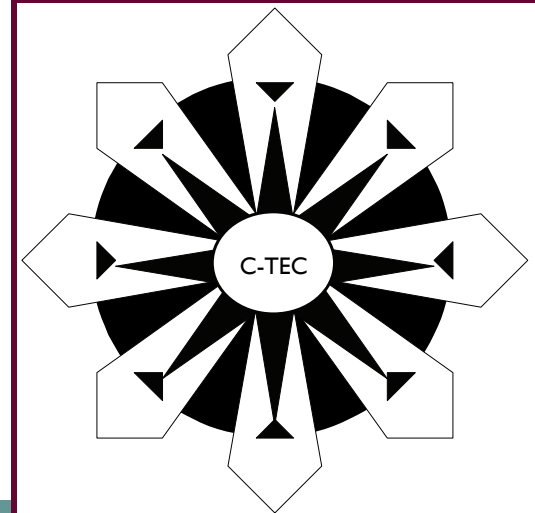

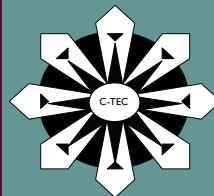

# About C-TEC Youth Services

Clackamas Technical Education Consortium (C-TEC) Youth Services providers work individually with youth to identify educational or training needs, determine interests, and set goals for advancement. Based upon their needs, interests, and goals, youth are engaged in any of the following activities:

- Paid and unpaid work experience
- Academic opportunities to assist in the completion of a high school diploma or GED
- Alternative education options
- Summer employment
- Occupational skills training
- Leadership opportunities
- Support services
- Adult mentoring
- Comprehensive guidance and counseling
- Follow-up and support services for 12 months after completion of program activities



## Eligibility Requirements

Youth must be:

- Residents of Clackamas County
- 14-21 years old
- Legally eligible to work in the United States
- Economically eligible
- Facing a barrier to employment or academic success

## Examples of Services

C-TEC Youth Services works to meet the individual needs of the youth through comprehensive case planning; however, various opportunities are offered to all C-TEC participants. Some examples include:



## Occupational Skills Training

C-TEC Youth Services coordinates a broad array of training opportunities that allow youth to gain entry-level skills in a variety of industries. Examples have been: Customer Service, CPR/First Aid, Intro to Culinary Arts, Spa Assistant, Roadway Flagging and Forklift Driving, and Chiropractic Assistant Training.

## Employment Made Possible (EMP)

EMP offers a weekly youth employment lab, assistance registering in the iMatchSkills employment database, job search support and resume assistance, among other services.

## Summer Youth Academy (SYA)

SYA offers C-TEC enrolled youth an eight week training program that includes basic job readiness skills, training in a focused field, and summer employment opportunities and assistance.



## Work Experience Opportunities

C-TEC Youth Services coordinates with local employers to offer paid and unpaid work experience opportunities to youth. Often times youth earn college credits through a partnership with Clackamas Community College as well as learning valuable job skills.
